#### Welcome Rev. Dr. Charles M. (Chuck) Cary

This morning, we welcome The Rev. Dr. Charles M. (Chuck) Cary to the pulpit. Dr. Cary is originally from Eastern Tennessee. He graduated from Maryville College and received his M.Div. and D.Min. from McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago.

Dr. Cary served as Pastor of the Westhampton Presbyterian Church from 1984 to 1999, and went on to hold an endowed 3-year professorship at McCormick Theological Seminary. He returned to Long Island to serve as Interim Pastor of the Old First Presbyterian Church in Huntington, then accepted a call as Senior Pastor of the 1200-member Moorings Presbyterian Church in Naples, Florida, from 2004-2010. He returned to New York to serve again as Pastor of Westhampton Presbyterian Church, then retired after a long and distinguished career.

Chuck and his wife, Millie, have three adult children and several grandchildren, to whom they are devoted. They enjoy traveling, visiting family and friends, and they divide their time between their home in East Quogue and their "snowbird" home in Florida.

Pastor Chuck Cary holds a special place in the heart of Pastor Ann; she was innocently sitting with the choir at Westhampton Presbyterian, listening to Chuck preach when God called her to the ministry. (She didn't realize it at the time; Chuck had to explain it to her.) He has served as mentor and encourager to Ann through seminary and beyond.
